





Continuation to Rabat the Administrative capital of the country, City tour: The Royal Palace, (Mechouar), the Oudaya Kasbah, the Mohamed V mausoleum, the Hassan Tower. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel.

Day 3 - Monday: RABAT / MEKNES / FEZ (220 km)





Departure by 4WD to Ouarzazate via the mountains of the high Atlas passing through the Tich'n'Tichka pass at an altitude of 2260 m, via Telouet, an absolutely stunning scenery. Visit of the Kasbah of Telouet, former residence of the Glaoui family, one of the most influential of this region. Optional Lunch, and visit of Kasbah Ait Benhadou. This kasbah is the most famous in Morocco and has served as setting for many famous movies. The Kasbah is now a UNESCO protected monument, continuation and Short visit of Ouarzazate including the Kasbah of Taourirt. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel.

Day 5 - Wednesday: OUARZAZATE / TINEGHIR /ERFOUD/ MERZOUGA (400 km)

After Breakfast, road to Boumalne and EL Kelâa via the road of the thousand Kasbahs, passing by Skoura. On the way,

we pass the beautiful kasbah of Amerhidel, visit of Canyon Dades and continuation to Tinghir. Tinghir is famous for its magnificent Todra canyons whose rocks reach an altitude of 250 meters. Excursion to the canyons and possibility for a short hike. (Optional) Lunch at a restaurant situated at the foot of the canyons. Continuation to the track road continues till Erfoud, then Merzouga. Dinner and accommodation in Merzouga, at hotel or under desert tents (NB: request must be done upon reservation of the tour).

Day 6 - Thursday: MERZOUGA /ALNIF / ZAGORA (310 km)

Early morning, a short walk to see the sunrise over the sand-dunes of Merzouga. Back to the Auberge for breakfast and departure to Zagora, via the village of Rissani, birthplace of the present Alaouites Dynasty. Continuation to Alnif, a small Berber village, for (Optional) lunch. Continuation to Zagora via Tazzarine and Taghbalt. On the way, splendid sceneries of pre-saharian desert dotted with Berber villages. Excursion to Tamegroute, visit of the famous library containing an impressive collection of old Manuscripts and documents dating from the 12th century. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel.

Day 7 - Friday: ZAGORA / OUARZAZATE / MARRAKESH (360 km)

After Breakfast, we head to MARRAKESH, from Agdz, we head forward on the track road leading through numerous villages and palm groves along the Drâa river before reaching Ouarzazate.

Optional Lunch.

Continuation Via the Tizin 'tichka pass, to Marrakesh. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel.

Then continuation to Ouarzazate and visit of the Kasbah of Tiffeltout and Taouirt, as well as the famous film studios Dinner and accommodation at the hotel.

Day 9 - Sunday: OUARZAZATE / ZAGORA (190 km)


After breakfast departure to Taznakth, famous for its Berber carpets., then continuation southwards to Agdz where we join again the road Ouarzazate-Zagora. From Agdz to Zagora is dotted with palm groves and numerous Kasbahs, most of them falling in ruins, but some are still worth a visit. In Zagora visit of the library of Tamgroute and the adjacent old Kasbah. Free lunch on the way. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel in Zagora or under Berber tents in Tinfou (request must be done upon reservation of the tour).

Day10 - Monday: ZAGORA / MARRAKESH (370 km)

Breakfast and then back to Ouarzazate following the same road till Agdz and then through the mountains of the Anti Atlas. Stop at noon in Ouarzazate for free lunch. Heading on to Marrakesh via the national road crossing the TiznTichkaPass. Arrival in Marrakesh, Dinner and accommodation.

Day 11- Tuesday: MARRAKESH / DEPARTURE

Transfer to the Menara Airport in Marrakesh, with Departure assistance formalities

Continuation to Rabat, the white imperial city and the administrative capital of the kingdom. lunch (optional FB Package) at local restaurant, the sightseeing includes the Mechouar (ramparts and walls surrounding the Royal Palace), the Oudaya Kasbah, the splendid Mohamed V mausoleum, the Hassan tower. Continuation to Meknes: the old medina is surrounded by a triple thickness of 40 km walls and preserves the most beautiful gate of Morocco, the Bab Mansour. Also, visit of the Royal stables of Moulay Ismael, the Medina and the Jewish quarter.

Continuation to Fez. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel.

Day 3 - Monday: FEZ

After breakfast, the whole day will be devoted to the sightseeing of Fez, the most ancient of the Imperial cities founded in the 8th century by Moulay Idriss II. Visit of the medieval Medina with its Attarine and Bou Anania Medersas (religious Islamic universities), the Nejjarine fountain, the Moulay Idriss mausoleum, and the Karaouine Mosque. Moroccan lunch (optional FB package) at a traditional restaurant in the Medina. Afternoon, visit of Fez Jdid. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel.

Day 4 - Tuesday: FEZ / MIDELT/ ERFOUD (400 km)

Departure to Erfoud via the mountains and the cedar woods of the middle Atlas passing by Ifrane, a charming ski station and Azrou, an important handicraft centre. Stop in Midelt for lunch (optional FB package). Continuation to Erfoud via Errachidia and the Ziz valley and its palm groves, which are the evident reason to organise the yearly date fruit Festival in Erfoud. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel

Day 5 - Wednesday: ERFOUD / RISSANI/ TINGHIR/ OUARZAZATE (390km)

Early morning, optional jeep excursion to see the sunrise over the sand-dunes of Merzouga. After breakfast continuation to Rissani. The holy city where Moulay Ali Cherif, ancestor of the Alaouite dynasty is buried. Visit of a kasbah of the 17th century and the KsarAbbar ruins, and continuation to Tinghir via the Tinjdad road. Visit of the magnificent Todgha canyons which rocks reach and altitude of 250 meters. Lunch (optional FB package) at a restaurant situated at the foot of the canyons and departure to the Dades canyons for a visit. Continuation to Ouarzazate via the road of the thousand kasbahs and the Dades valley famous for its roses and the yearly Moussem (rose Festival). Visit of the kasbah of Taourirt. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel in Ouarzazate.

Day 6- Thursday: OUARZAZATE /AIT BENHADDOU /MARRAKESH (230 km)

Visit of the Kasbahs of Taouirt Tiffeltout and Ait Ben Haddou, the most spectacular fortress in the south of Morocco, which has been the set of many films like "Laurence of Arabia". Lunch (Optional FB package) at the terrace of the restaurant facing the Kasbah. Departure to Marrakesh via the Tichka pass offering an impressive landscape in the heart of the Atlas mountain chain.

Dinner and accommodation at the hotel.

Day 7 - Thursday: MARRAKESH

The entire day will be devoted to the visit of Marrakesh, the second oldest Imperial city, known as the pearl of the South. The city was founded by the Almoravides at the end of the 11th century. The historical sightseeing includes the Menara garden, the Saadian tombs, the Bahia palace and the Koutoubia. Lunch at the hotel.

Afternoon, visit of the souks and handicraft quarters displaying a variety of items and the famous "Place Djemâa El Fna" with its non-stop entertainment. Dinner with Fantasia Show (optional). Accommodation at the hotel.



After breakfast, discovery of this magical fortified coastal city. You will explore the port, the Scala, the municipal market, jeweler's quarter and a handicrafts complex, with the company of your guide. After 3 hours of sightseeing you will enjoy a lunch time in Val D'Argan: the only real Bodega in Morocco with stunning views over the countryside, you will be sitting on a shaded terrace sipping a glass of cool white wine with goat Cheese. Back to Essaouira you will visit a women Argan Oil cooperative, made with the fruit of that Argan tree which grows nowhere else than on the West coast of Morocco. Later, you may have an optional dinner. Our suggestion: dining at "Sams", a world-famous fish restaurant at the end of the harbour...

Day 5: Essaouira - Agadir (Departure)

After breakfast, you will head back to the Agadir airport for your flight back.



Arrival at the airport of Fez. Welcoming, assistance and transfer to your hotel.

Day 2: Fez - Sefrou - Fez

Morning will be devoted to the sightseeing of Fez, the oldest cultural and spiritual imperial city of Morocco, which was founded at the end of the 8th Century by Moulay Idriss II. The visit will include the Medieval Medina, the Medersas, the El Qaraouiyyin Mosque (external), and the sumptuous Nejjarine fountain.

During your visit, you will have the chance to discover a coranic school and to be invited to a cup of tea by a local family. After lunch in a Riad, you will explore Sefrou in the suburbs of Fez and its jewish quarter, as well as the waterfalls (seasonal). Sefrou is an important agricultural site where the Cherry Festival is celebrated every year in June. Back to Fez, overnight at your hotel.

Day 3: Fez - Ifrane - Azrou - Fez


Breakfast and departure to Ifrane.

After the breakfast, you will head to the city of Ifrane, which is about 1 h 25 min driving away (94,6 km). On the way, you will be crossing the fertile country fields, and enjoy the landscapes of Fez/Boulemane's region. On the way, the Atlas Mountains offer a beautiful view, especially when they are covered with snow. You will have a stop at the town of Imouzzer, which is known for its apple festival taking place in September. Continuation to Ifrane and Azrou and to the National park, the largest Cedar forest of Morocco, where you can find numerous lakes, water sources and a variety of birds, monkeys and fishes.

Lunch and back to Fez.

Day 4: Fez - Departure

After breakfast, transfer to Fez International airport for your return flight and assistance with the boarding formalities.



Day 1: Fez

Arrival to Fez International Airport and transfer to your hotel or Riad. After the check-in, you will go for an Apetizer on the Sahrai Terrace. Overnight.

Day 2: Fez - Meknes - Volubilis - Fez

Morning will be devoted to the sightseeing of Fez, the oldest cultural and spiritual imperial city of Morocco, which was founded at the end of the 8th Centry by Moulay Idriss II. The visit will include the Medieval Medina, the Medersas, the El Qaraouiyyin Mosque (external), and the sumptuous Nejjarine fountain.

During your visit, you will have the chance to discover a coranic school and to be invited to a cup of tea by a local family. Lunch and departure to Meknes and Volubilis.

Meknes, with its monumental gates and city walls, was founded at the end of the 17th century by the Sultan Moulay Ismail. Visit of Bab el Mansour and Bab Khemiss, two timeless masterpeaces, and the Moulay Ismail Mausoleum.

Continuation to Volublis, the ancient Roman city and back to Fez for your overnight.


Day 3: Fez - Chefchaouen - Tetouan - Fez
